Mr. McCall also provisioned campus utilities and acted as a University liaison with architects, engineers, contractors and local government entities. Although retired from UHD, he continues to assist the university in campus planning and special projects.

Mr. McCall earned his Bachelor of Science in Building Construction from Texas A&M University. His certifications include: Association of Physical Plant Administrator (APPA) Education Facility Professional and International Facility Management Association (IFMA) Certified Facility Manager.
